Humility

Luke 14:11 - *For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.*

"We must view humility as one of the most essential things that characterizes true Christianity." – Jonathan Edwards

Humility is having a right view of yourself

Romans 12:3 (NLT) – *Because of the privilege and authority God has given me, I give each of you this warning: Don't think you are better than you really are. Be honest in your evaluation of yourselves, measuring yourselves by the faith God has given us.*

Romans 12:3 NIV – *Think of yourself with sober judgment.*

Be the "you" God designed you to be.

Attitude of Humility

Philippians 2:5-8 - *"Have the same mindset as Christ. Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!"*

Action of Humility

Philippians 2:3–4 - *Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.*
